From the Pastor's Desk

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope."

- Jeremiah 29:11



Greetings in the Name of our Faithful and Powerful God.

This past month has been a month of doctor appointments and hospital visits for me. It was a very troubling time in my life, as I am sure many of you have experienced yourselves. During the lonesome hours, thinking and praying, and walking along with God, my mind dwelt upon many passages of Scripture. Thank you, Pastor Duer, and Pastor Ott for so diligently making me memorize those passages in my school days.

The verse above has always been a comfort to me. It was given to Jeremiah for the Israelites, basically the tribes of Judah and Benjamin, while they were in captivity in Babylon. They were captive there for 70 years, away from their land and their homes. We can only imagine how depressed and lost they might have felt, but they were not alone, and they were not lost. Their God Yahweh was with them. We see Him acting during that time in the books of Daniel and Esther. We see Him acting in a very powerful way during that time. Three men in a fiery furnace, Daniel in the Lions' den, the foreigner who became queen Esther are three of those stories. We also have God sending prophets to them with His messages. Jeremiah is one of those.

Amid the darkness and desolation, during the captivity, God reassures them that they are not forgotten by Him, nor are they forsaken by Him. He knows the thoughts He has towards them, thoughts to give them a future and a hope. Ultimately that hope and future are tied to Jesus Christ, but in their short term it also represents a return to their land and their life in the promised land. A rebuilding of Jerusalem and the Temple, a reclaiming of their family lands, a return to normal life.

God, however, sees the future, and what will happen when they return to the land, so He encourages them not to forsake their pathway with Him. Jeremiah 29:12-14, *Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.* ¹³ *And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.* ¹⁴ *I will be found by you, says the LORD, and I will bring you back from your captivity.*

Israel did forget God, and failed to seek Him out with their heart, soul, and might. They returned to their normal life, but they forgot God. They walked their own pathways, and lived their own lives. They did not call on Him, or seek Him, and finally they did not recognize that future and hope He gave them in Jesus.

I have a challenge for you. As your Pastor, I challenge you for the next six months to choose one Bible verse that brings you hope and comfort each week, then memorize that verse, and repeat it to yourselves several times a day, perhaps at each meal and when you go to bed and when you get up. I will even help you out, and put one of my favorite verses in the announcements each Sunday. You don't have to use that one, but you may. At the end of six months you will have a treasure stored up in your heart and mind with 26 verses from God's own Word, a wealth of strength and comfort, no matter what the challenge is. God knows the plans He has for you, may that be a comfort for you.


